



## 2010 NPAA FAST PITCH SOFTBALL

NPAA Softball was started 7 years ago as a division of NPAA Baseball. During that time, our teams have played under the banner of the Media Area Girls' Softball League. Beginning with the 2010 season, we are pleased to announce that our fast pitch teams will be playing under the Nether Providence banner.

Tryouts will be conducted on Saturday, February 13<sup>th</sup> at the Strath Haven High School Gym from 1:00 until 3:00, and on another date to be determined. The travel program will consist of at least one team in each age bracket (U8, U10, U12, U14 and U16). These teams will participate in the Del Val Softball League, which is a fast pitch league that includes teams in nearby towns in Delaware County. The season runs from mid April through early July.

Players who are interested in playing at a higher level of competition and are committed to developing their softball skills should consider playing fast pitch softball. If this is not what you want, we encourage you to play slow pitch softball in Media. Our relationship with Media has been a good one over the past seven years and we anticipate that continuing for many years to come. The only thing that has changed is that Nether Providence now has its own fast pitch club. If you want to play in the Media slow pitch league, please register directly with Media. Your child will need to be registered to participate in the tryouts. The tryout fee is \$75. If your daughter makes the team, this fee will be credited to the final registration fee (which is yet to be determined). If your daughter does not make the team, this fee will register you in the Media slow pitch league.
